NOTICE SPAM FILTER

In the ongoing battle against spam, our Internet Service Provider has increased restrictions on outgoing mail by lowering the number of messages that can be sent out as "blind carbon copies" (i.e. where the recipient's name and addresses do not appear in the address line of the message). As well, there are restrictions on the total number of messages which may be sent out per day, and per hour.

Because of this, we experienced problems sending out the previous newsletter. Apologies to anyone who received duplicate messages, or whom we may have missed.

With this newsletter, we are trying out a new mailing program that should eliminate the problem of too many bcc recipients. However, we may need to stagger the mailing over a few hours. We will do our best to notify all CLPENS members on the same day.
